

## **Instructions for buyers to claim incentives under the Haryana EV Policy 2022**

Department of Industries & Commerce, Government of Haryana has notified the **Haryana Electric Vehicle Policy-2022**. The EV Policy aims to promote manufacturing of electric vehicle and components in the state, promote Research and Development in the sector, give boost to charging infrastructure providers and give incentive to buyers of EV and hybrid EV to reduce the upfront cost of the vehicles.

Purchase incentives have been provided to buyers of EV and Hybrid electric vehicles to enhance the EV market share in the state. Following eligibility is to be ensured for claiming purchase incentive of EV buyers.

1. Buyer should be an individual person and vehicle should not be in the name of company, firm, society, etc.
2. The Vehicle should be Pure Electric Vehicle, Fuel Cell Electric Vehicle, Strong Hybrid Electric Vehicle, Plug-In Hybrid Electric Vehicle.
3. Category of vehicles incentivized will be Electric Car/light EV, Hybrid Electric Car/ Hybrid Light EV (SHEV/PHEV), Hydrogen based vehicle, Electric Tractors for farmers, Hybrid Electric tractor for farmers, Electric Bus
4. Vehicles not falling in above category will not be eligible for incentives
5. Following definitions will be followed for Hybrid electric vehicles
  - a. Strong Hybrid Electric Vehicle: Strong Hybrid Electric Vehicle (SHEV) is a HEV which has an engine 'Stop-Start' arrangement, 'Electric Regenerative Braking System' and a 'Motor Drive' (motor alone is capable to propel/drive the vehicle from a stationary condition)
  - b. Plug-in Hybrid Electric vehicle: PHEV is a type of 'Strong Hybrid Electric Vehicle' which has a provision for 'Off Vehicle Charging' (OVC) of 'Rechargeable Energy Storage System (ReESS)'.
6. Vehicles purchased and registered after 10 July 2022 will be incentivized
7. Buyers are eligible to apply on <https://investharyana.in> for claiming incentive within 45 days of launch of portal.
